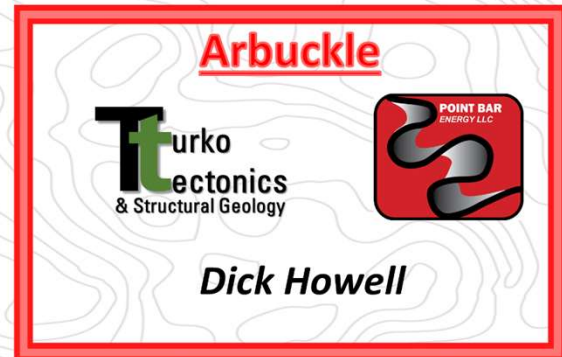
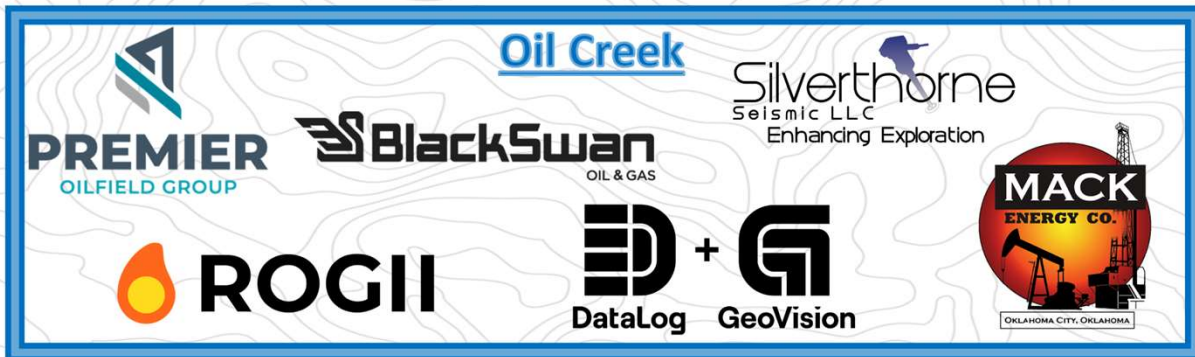

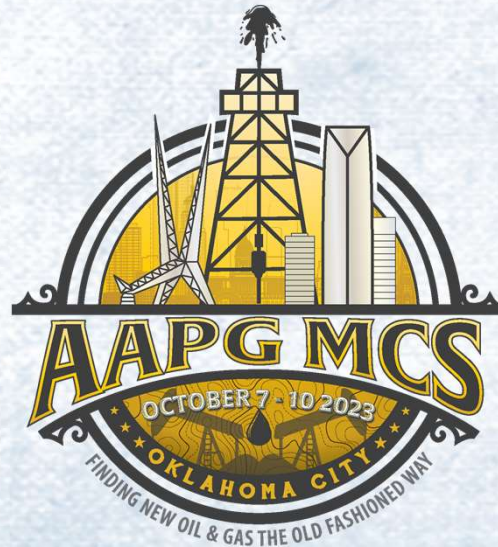

- 2022 Student Membership Drive:
 - +16 new students from OSU, OU, Tulsa, and Rose State
- Backpay 2022+ dues
 - 8 of 17 members paid

2023 Goals:

1. Finalize transition to MCPPro member management system


- Readership down by 50%
